■ An extraordinary trip for enthusiasts of the hydro-architecture. Over 200 kilometers on RIB boats and jet skis, from Wrocław to Gliwice, along the Odra River and Gliwicki Canal. From Wrocław to the mouth of the Gliwicki Canal we pass through 18 locks. Each of them is around 200 meters long, enough to fit a towboat with two coal barges. On the Gliwicki Canal another six locks await (including two with a difference in water level of over 10 meters). In some sections of the canal, the embankment rises to more than 4 meters in height.

ITINERARY

- **DAY 1**
9.00 – training program for the participants – jet ski lessons, introduction of general safety rules and regulations.
10.00 – start from Wrocław. During the day we pass 15 locks on the Odra river, leaving behind the scenic, historical towns of Lower Silesia – Olawa, Brzeg and Opole. By the late afternoon we approach the town of Krapkowice with its spectacular 13th century, quadrilateral castle overlooking the town. Lunch in a cruise break.
18.00 – dinner and night in Krapkowice.
- **DAY 2**
10.00 – breakfast, start from Krapkowice. Passing three locks on the Odra River we reach Kedzierzyn-Kozle. From there we follow the Gliwicki Canal, passing through the next six locks and overcoming a 40-meter difference in water levels. Lunch in a cruise break.
17.00 – end of cruise – Gliwice.

ADVENTURE ADD-ON

- **Gliwicki Canal** – a waterway connecting the Odra River with the city of Gliwice, mainly used for transporting coal. It was built in 1935-1941 to replace the old **Klodnicki Canal** which dates back to the reign of Frederick William II, king of Prussia. Between 1939 and 1945 it was named Adolf Hitler's Canal after the German dictator. At present the length of the canal is 40,6 km. Six locks of some 200 meters length (enough for the tow boat with two coal barges to fit) enable the canal to conquer a difference in water levels of 43.6 meters between ends. One of the most impressive locks is **"the Klodnica Lock"** which alone overcomes a water level differential of 10 meters! One of the curiosities of the canal is the Klodnica siphon, a collision-free junction of the two waterways – the Klodnica River and Gliwicki Canal, where the river flows in the tunnel below the canal.
